POOL RULES

Pool Hours:

Monday through Thursday 12:00 noon to 7:00 p.m.

Friday 12:00 noon to 10:00 p.m.

Saturday and Sunday, 12:00 noon to 8:00 p.m.

Guest Privileges

1. Guests must be accompanied by the inviting member
2. Previous members of CSRC who have not reinstated their membership for the current year may not come to the pool as a guest
3. On legal holidays, the pool is available only to members and their overnight houseguests from outside the membership.
4. Local guests of members, from outside the membership, are welcome, other than on prohibited days.
5. Limit of two (2) guests per member daily.

Pool Regulations

1. During normal pool hours, children under 9 years of age must be accompanied by an adult (18 years old). Proof of age for caretaker must be presented upon request by lifeguard and/or board members.
2. Children 9 to 12 years old entering the pool unaccompanied by an adult must, to the satisfaction of the pool manager and/or lifeguard, be able to:
 - swim 2 lengths of the pool without touching the bottom
 - tread water for 90 seconds in the deep end of the pool
 - go off diving board and swim to the ladderA notation of the child having passed the test will be made on the Membership Roster.
3. Only bathing suits are permitted in the pool – no cut offs are allowed.
4. Regular disposable diapers are not permitted in the pool.
Untrained children are required to wear swim diapers beneath their swim suits.
5. No animals are permitted in the pool area.
6. No food or beverages in glass containers are allowed inside the pool area. Eating and drinking should be done 5 feet from pool edge.
7. Trash receptacles are provided for your use. Please do not throw trash on the ground. Help your membership grounds by picking up any trash.
8. No smoking within 10 feet of pool. Smokers must be 18 years of age and should use a cigarette urn. No cigarette butts on pool area grounds are allowed.
9. No hairpins or metal objects are allowed in pool.
10. No skateboards or bicycles inside the pool gate.
11. Annoyance or unnecessary conversation with lifeguard on duty is not permitted.
12. During adult swim, only infants and children under 2 are allowed in the pool with their parent.

Safety Rules and Regulations

1. No running or horseplay in the pool area.
2. No pushing or throwing anyone in the pool.
3. Divers should be sure the pool is clear below the diving area before making a dive.
4. Only one person is allowed on the diving board at a time.
5. Children in the diving area using flotation devices (rings, armfloats, etc.) must be accompanied by an adult.
6. No diving is allowed in the shallow end of the pool.
7. Children with flotation devices are not allowed to go off the diving board.
8. No tennis balls allowed in the pool.

Club Equipment

1. Property or furnishings shall not be removed from the Club premises without prior approval from the Board.
2. Members will be responsible to the Club for any debts, damage, and breakage caused by misuse by them or their guest(s). All members are responsible for their guest(s).

Miscellaneous

1. Cricket Swim & Racquet Club is not responsible for lost articles.
2. Abusive or foul language shall not be allowed on Club premises at any time.
3. No member or guest shall reprimand or discipline any pool employee, but shall bring his complaint to a member of the Pool Committee.

Enforcement of Rules & Regulations

1. All rules and regulations are approved by the Board of Directors.
2. All members shall assist in the enforcement of the rules and regulations and shall report all infractions and violations to the Pool Committee Chairperson.
3. The pool manager or lifeguard on duty will have the authority to enforce any and all rules and regulations and expel any person violating these from the pool.
4. Expulsion from the pool will be reported to the Pool Committee Chairperson and the President of the Board of Directors.
5. Expulsion from the pool will result in suspension of pool privileges as follows:

-1 st expulsion:	1 day suspension from the pool
-2 nd expulsion:	3 days suspension from the pool
-3 rd expulsion:	1 week suspension from the pool
-4 th expulsion:	1 month suspension from the pool
-5 th expulsion:	remainder of summer suspension from the pool

Any *guest* expelled from the pool may not return to the pool for the remainder of the summer.

6. The Pool Committee Chairperson and/or the Board of Directors reserve the right to use any of the above suspensions depending on the severity of the infraction.

Pool Rental Rules

Hours available: Any evening after pool closing 7:00 p.m. to 11:00 p.m.

Making reservations:

1. Only members in good standing may reserve the pool.
2. The member must request pool rental at least 14 days in advance.
3. The pool is reserved by contacting the Pool Committee Chairperson.
4. The following information must be provided to the Committee Chairperson:
 - The date and time of the event
 - the number of guests scheduled to attend
 - the age range of the guests (under 10, 10-21, adult only)
 - if alcoholic beverages will be served
 - any special instructions

Rental fees:

1. The renter is required to submit a \$100.00 security deposit at the time that the reservation is made. A \$50.00 refund will be made to the renter if:
 - The pool and pool area are left clean and free of trash
 - No damage has occurred to the pool area, grounds or building
 - Any damage to the Club property above and beyond the \$50.00 is the responsibility of the member renting the pool.
2. The cost per lifeguard is set by the pool maintenance company and may be subject to change. The current charge is \$25.00 per lifeguard per hour. Lifeguard fees are to be paid at the time that the reservation is made with the Pool Committee Chairperson.

The scale below shall be used to determine the number of lifeguards required:

<u># of people scheduled to attend</u>	<u># of lifeguards required</u>
1-25	1
26-50	2
51-75	3
76-100	4

*One additional lifeguard shall be required for any teenage party, college age party, or any party involving alcoholic beverages. Fraternity parties are not available for scheduling.

Rules

1. All pool rules of the Cricket Swim & Racquet Club are to be followed.
2. The adult club member renting the pool must be in attendance at all times.
3. Only lifeguards secured by the Pool Committee Chairperson will be used for the pool rentals.

4. No drugs are allowed on Club property.
5. No alcoholic beverages are allowed on Club property at any event for minors.
6. If alcoholic beverages are found at any event for minors, the lifeguard will close the pool at once and notify the Pool Committee Chairperson.
7. If the lifeguard must close the pool during the event for reasons other than weather related, there will be no refund of the security deposit, and the member renting the pool will not be allowed to rent the pool again.
8. No beverages in glass bottles or containers are allowed inside the pool fence.

Number of Guests

1. Events for groups under 10-21 years of age are limited to 50 people.
2. Events for adults only or families –the member using the pool should use discretion.
3. The pool may be rented only for times specified in pool rental rules. If the pool is ready and lifeguards are available prior to the opening date, the pool may be rented with the approval of the Pool Committee Chairperson. Pool may not be rented after closing date.

Adult Supervision

The ratio of adult supervision will be

- Events for age groups under 10 years of age: 1 adult for each group of 5 children in attendance.
- Events for age groups 10-20 years of age: 1 adult for each group of 10 in attendance.
